KAIROS Blanket Exercise, Sunday May 15, 12:00 – 2:30 pm

St. John's Norway Anglican Church, 470 Woodbine Ave., is hosting a KAIROS Blanket Exercise today from 12noon – 2:30pm downstairs in their fellowship room. All are welcome. It's free. The KAIROS Blanket Exercise (KBE) is an interactive and experiential teaching tool that explores the historic and contemporary relationship between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples in the land we now know as Canada. During this workshop, participants step on blankets representing the land



and into the role of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples. They are guided by trained facilitators, including Indigenous Elders and Knowledge Keepers, who work from a script that covers pre-contact, treaty-making, colonization, resistance and much more. Environmental Tip of the Week


Garden clean-up tips: Thanks to BUC Garden Club

Some bees nest above ground in stems of dead plants. Instead of removing dead stems leave the hollow stems at 6"-18". You will have created bee hotels for twig nesting bees to lay their offspring. Next year the offspring emerge and they're ready for new bees.

Leave fallen leaves in the garden if possible. Leaves are full of nutrients and can help your soil stay healthy. If you're worried about leaves on plants susceptible to fungal diseases, mulch leaves or put them in an active composter. Leaves are a good source of browns supplying carbon to your compost.
