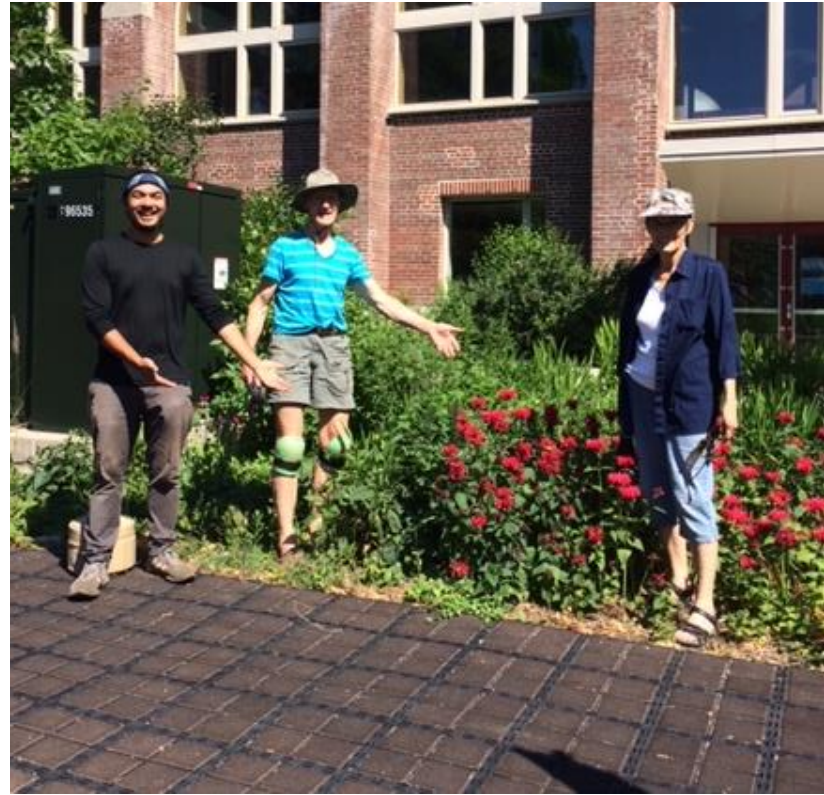

SOUTH BORDER OF PARKING LOT - - OVER RUN WITH WEEDS

Last year two large shade trees in backyards of our Queen St. neighbours were cut down. The result – what used to be a heavy shade area has been opened up to full sun. Weeds have taken advantage and started taking over from the Hosta,
