# **CLAIRE'S SWEATER IN THE ROUND**



Gauge: 16 stitches = 4 inches

Sizes: 3 months (6 months, 9-12 months)

Yardage: 250(300,350)

Needles: 5.5 mm circular needle (16 inch works well) or size needed for gauge; double pointed

needle of same size

# **Abbreviations**

WS wrong side RS right side YO yarn over SM slip marker PM place marker

SSK slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over

K2tog knit 2 together

Kfb Knit into the front and back of the stitch

RM remove marker

DP double pointed needle

### Pattern: Body

Cast on 45 (50,51) stitches, using long tail cast on method

(First section knitted straight, not in the round)

Row 1: (WS) Knit to end (do not join)

Row 2: (RS) Knit to end Row 3: (WS) Knit to end

Row 4: Knit to end, at the same time increasing 4 stitches, using Kfb, evenly spaced across row

Row 5 (WS) Knit **10 (11,11)** (front), PM, knit **6 (7,7)** (sleeve), PM, knit **17 (18,19)** (back), PM, knit **6 (7,7)** (sleeve), PM, knit **10 (11,11)** (front)

Row 6: (RS) (Knit to 1 stitch before the next marker, Kfb, SM, Kfb) 4 times, knit to end (8 stitches increased)

Row 7: (WS) Knit 7 stitches, purl to the last 7 stitches, knit 7 (this forms the edging)

Work rows 6 and 7 6 (7,8) times total. You will have 10 (11,12) raglan increases, 129 (142, 151) stitches total.

#### Divide for Sleeves

Row 10: (RS) Knit to the sleeve stitches, RM, slip the **26(29, 31)** sleeve stitches onto a piece of scrap yarn, RM, knit across the back, RM, slip the sleeve **26(29, 31)** stitches onto a piece of scrap yarn, RM, knit to end **70(77, 82)** stitches.

Row 11: (WS) Knit 7, purl to the last 7 stitched, knit 7

Row 12: Knit edging stitches together: With wrong side facing, slip 7 edging stitches from right-hand needle onto DP needle. Holding DP needle behind circular needle, knit 7 stitches from both needles together (knit 1 stitch from front needle together with 1 st from back needle. Repeat 6 more times), forming closed circle and overlapping edging. (If too complicated, bind off 7 edging stitches of one edge, and then sew seam together when finishing the sweater.)

Continue knitting sweater in the round, placing a marker under the first sleeve reached to mark beginning of row. Knit all rows to desired length: 5'' ( $5\frac{1}{2}$ ",  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ").

Row 13: (WS) Purl Row 14: (RS) Knit

Work rows 13 and 14 2(2,3) times total

Bind off purl wise.

### **Sleeves**

Note: Work each sleeve separately, in the round and place a marker at start of round 26 (29,31) stitches. Leave a 6" tail when joining yarn so you can sew closed the hole under each arm.

## **Short Sleeves**

Round 1: Knit to end of row. Work round 1 **3(4,4)** times total. Go to the edging section.

### **Long Sleeves**

Round 1: Knit to the end.

Repeat round for 1"

Round 2: Knit 1, K2tog, knit to the last 3 stitches, SSK, knit 1.

Work rounds 1 and 2 once again 22(25,27) stitches.

Repeat Round 1 until the sleeve measures 4½ (5, 6) inches from the under arm or to desired length.

# **Edging of Sleeves**

Round 3: Purl to the end Round 4: Knit to the end

Work rounds 3 and 4 2 (2,3) times total.

Bind off purl-wise.

Repeat as worked for the 2<sup>nd</sup> sleeve.

### **Finishing**

Weave in ends, sew underarms, block and enjoy!
